Activity description
<p>Fact or opinion, and if fact is it true or false – Lots of bat-related Qs</p> <p>Cut out of baths and moths too. Can be used as part of a treasure hunt.</p> <p>Can also play bat-moth to learn about echolocation (Everyone stands in a circle, a “bat” is chosen and a “moth”. The bat is blindfolded, and has to call out “bat”, the moth instantly replies with “moth” and the bat has to catch the moth, while the moth tries to get away. Both are constrained within the circle of people.</p>
